Newmarket School District Annual Meeting

Second Session: March 12, 2024

The second session of the Town of Newmarket Annual Meeting was called to order and voting polls were opened at 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 12, 2024, at the Newmarket Town Hall.

The ballots had been verified, counted and tested. Sample ballots and election signs were posted.

Processing of absentee ballots (9) began at 9:00 a.m. The checklist included 6,542 registered voters. A total of 656 ballots were cast.

The polls were declared closed at 7:00 p.m. Moderator Hawkins announced the Town and School Election Results.
